

I Saiah Pickett's portion of Said Bond under Said decree and that the said Saiah Pickett doth hereby further Submit to any decree in South Carolina or north Carolina that will be in obedience to the Confirmation and Support of Said decree with such further credits of such property that the said Saiah Received of his father in his Lifetime as the Court of South Carolina may decree against the said Saiah and also and further may it be Remembered to all persons whom it may concern that I Saiah Pickett doth hereby Receive of James Pickett of Said district the Sum of six hundred and ten dollars for which Sum I Saiah Pickett doth hereby sell and deliver in to the Right and Interest of James Pickett all the Ballance which is yet due or will be due to the said Saiah Pickett Both the land and personal property under the Will of Micajah Pickett deceased and also all the Ballance which is due or will be due said Saiah by the said Bond and decree to the said James Pickett to him and his heirs for ever free and clear from the said Saiah Pickett and his heirs or any other person or persons whatsoever as witness hereunto the said Saiah Pickett doth set his hand and affix his seal this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord A.D. 1823 and being the fifty second year of the Independence of the united States of America

 Know all men by these presents that we John C Sullivan Thomas J Sullivan and George W Sullivan Executors of the Estate of Hulet Sullivan Deceased of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the Sum of Two hundred and Seventy Six dollars to us in hand paid by Amos Eskew of the district and State aforesaid have Granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said Amos Eskew a certain tract or piece of Land containing one hundred and thirty Eight acres more or less it being a part of a tract originally granted to Benjamin Farmer Survey on the 30th day of October 1799 and recorded in the Location office the 28th of February 1800 Beginning on a red oak thence N 60 E 45.50 to a stake thence S 20 E 17 to a stake thence S 15 W 29 to a gum in a swamp thence S 76 W 27.50 to a red oak thence N 20 W 30 to the Beginning corner together with all and singular the rights members Accretions and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Amos Eskew his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Amos Eskew his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and against Every person Whomesoever lawfully claiming or to claim the Same or any
