granted to Joseph Bridges thence with said line to a stake corner thence with said
line crossing a creek to a corner on a rock on James Fars line thence near an East
course to a Poplar corner on a line formerly Thomas Dunagens thence to a post oak
& Clevelands corner thence along said Clevelands line to an ash in a branch
thence down the branch to the River thence up the River as it meanders to the Be-
ginning containing three hundred acres be the same more or less being the same
Land conveyed me by John Thurston Together with all and singular the Rights
members here detements and appertainances thereunto belonging to have and
to hold all and singular the aforesaid premises to the said James Farr his heirs and
assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to Warrant
