and Payment Whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Granted Bargained and  
Sold and by these presents do Grant Bargain and sell unto the Said Jeremiah  
Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever the Said tract piece and parcel of land  
with its appertaining and all the Estate right title and Interest which the  
Said John H. Goodlett of right had of in and to the same to have and to  
hold the Said piece parcel and tract of land with its appertaining unto the  
Said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely  
as I the Said William Blasingame might could or ought to Grant Bargain  
and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the Said writ of fieri  
facias or otherwise in witness Whereof I the Said William Blasingame have  
hereunto set my hand and seal the fourth day of October in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two
