

L32 State of South Carolina

This Indenture made the seventh day of September in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty between William Choice Esqr Commiss
ioner of the Honourable Court of Equity for Greenville district at Greenville Court
House in the said State of the one part and Phillip Evans of the district and
State aforesaid of the other part Whereas John H. Harrison as surviving Testate
on or about the seventh day of January 1828 did Exhibit his Bill of Complaint
in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against James
Wilcox Stating among other things that John Wright in his life time made and
Executed a Deed of Trust for certain property for the use and Benefit of his
Wife Jane Wright to James Harrison since deceased and the Complainant
in that certain lands and other property were included in the said
Deed and the cause being at Issue before the Honourable Court came on to
be heard at July Term 1829 when the said Court after full hearing thereof
and Mature Deliberation in the premises did order adjudged and decree
that the said tract of Land Should be Sold at public auction by the Commiss
ioner of the said Court on the Terms and for the purposes mentioned in their
decretal order as by Reference thereto in the Register of the said Court after
having duly advertised will appear and the said William Choice as
Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said
Land for Sale by Public out bid on the fourth day of January 1830
did then openly and Publicly and according to the custom of auctions
Sell and dispose of the said tract of land below described unto the
said Phillip Evans for two thousand dollars being at that price the highest
Bidder for the same Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the
said William Choice as Commissioner of the said Court under and by
virtue of the said decree and in consideration of the sum of two
thousand dollars paid by him the said Phillip Evans the Receipt
Whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Granted Bargained Sold and
Released and by these presents doth Grant Bargain Sell and Release
unto the said Phillip Evans his heirs and assigns all that planta
tion or tract of Land Situate in the district of Greenville on Reedy
River containing five hundred acres begining on a stake by a red
oak on the east Bank of Reedy River Running S. 70 E. 7.50 to a stake by
a pine then S. 46 E. 6.50 to the river thence straight across the River to the
West Bank of said River then up the Bank of the River West 4.50 to a stake then
S. 54 W. 13.50 to a red oak stump then a straight line as the road runs to a
pine then S. 25 E. by a pine Root to a poplar in a branch then 15 chains up
the Branch on Baldwyns line to a maple then N. 20 E. 12.50 to a red oak on
John Burtons line then W. 46 chs to the road then up the road 50 chains to a
stake by red oak then N. 38 E. 16. to a pine then N. 30 E. 27 to a light wood
stake N. 45 E. 27 to a post oak S. 60 E. 10 to a post oak S. 17 E. 10 to a poplar
then down the Branch to the river and then down the River to the Beginning
Together with all and singular the Hereditaments Rights members and
appertinances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or in any
wise appertaining and the Reversion and remainders rents issues
and profits thereof and also all the Estate Right title Interest dower prop
erty Benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at law
and equity of the heirs and Representatives of the said James Wilcox
