-er corner thence South East to a Red oak corner of a tract of land of  
David Pedens thence along Said line to the Beginning corner which Includes  
the quantity of Land to be conveyed to the Said Dan Peden and I the said  
James S. Peden doth forever Warrant and defend the above Described  
200 acres more or less from myself my heirs Executors administrators  
or assigns or any other person or persons Whomever claiming or to  
claim the Said land or any part thereof but to be only to the Said Dan
