and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty  
dollars to me in hand paid by George Seaburn of the said State  
and district the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted  
Bargained Sold released and confirmed and by these presents do  
grant Bargain Sell release bosaloy and confirm unto the said  
George Seaburn and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of Land  
lying on mountain creek of Saludia river and laid out to George  
Seaburn as follows Beginning on a hickory on the creek running  
West 3.80 to a <sup>thence S 8° E 18.20 to a hickory thence N 87° E 2.85</sup>  
to a post oak thence N 40 W 1.82 to the creek thence up said creek  
to the begining including four acres more or less it being a part  
of the tract on which I now live To Have and to hold the said  
parcel or tract of land together with all and singular the  
rights members fixtures and appurtenances belonging  
or in any wise appertaining and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs & to warrant and ever defend the said Bargained  
premises unto the said George Seaburn his heirs & forever a  
gainst me and my heirs and against every other person  
or persons claiming the or any part thereof witness my hand  
and seal this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1831.)
