

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that We the heirs and Legates of Willis Buttes late of Greenville district in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of four hundred dollars have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto Edward G. Buttes of said district all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and ninety acres more or less situate in said State and district on both sides of Grey's Branch of Gilgus Creek of Enoree river beginning on a post oak 3x on the Indian Boundary line and runs and runs on John Buttes line due West 22 chains to a Spanish oak 3x then with William Stone line due South 52 chains 30 links to a stake 3x then on William Goldsmiths land due East 22 chains to a red oak Bush 3x on the Indian Boundary line then on Hartwell Sesters lines due North 10 chains 67 links to a black Jack and Stake 3x due East 22 chains 33 links to a post oak 3x due North 33 chains 33 links to a post oak 3x due West 22 chains 50 links to a post oak 3x on the Indian Boundary line due North 8 chains 30 links to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the said Edward G. Buttes his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edward G. Buttes his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever blaiming or to be blaimed the same or any part thereof Witness our hands and seals this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 1832
