Baylis Earle of the same place and the payment of which is secured
at and before the sealing of these presents have granted Bargained Sold
and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and release
unto the Said Baylis Earle all that plantation and tract of land
in the district of Greenville on Brasby creek being part of the Entire
tract where I lately resided and which was conveyed to me by John
Barnhill and Including also a small parcel adjoining thereto conveyed
to me by Vardry McBee and butting and bounding as follows,
Beginning at a maple 3x on the Branch on the Western Side of the tract
thence N. 45. E. 13 chains 50 links to a red oak 3x thence N. 33. E. 14 chains
14 links to a post oak 3x thence N. 80. E. 19 chains 50 links to a stake formerly
Red oak 3x, on the augusta road north of the fork thence S. 65. E. 14 chains
to a stake 3x in the old field in front of the house thence S. 84. E. 4 chains to
