Greenville District } Know all men by these presents that I Robert Duncan of the district and State aforesaid for and Inconsideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Perry E Duncan of the district and State aforesaid the receipt of which is hereby Acknowledged have Granted Bargained and Sold and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and convey unto the Said Perry E Duncan all that tract or parcel of Land on Which I now reside & situate living and being on the North Side of Reedy River commencing at the entrance of Duncans Branch into Said Reedy River and thence up Said Duncans Branch to the mouth of the first Spring or Still house branch on the East Side and thence up Said Spring Branch about two chains to a Spanish oak corner thence nearly a parallel course with Said Duncans Branch on a line as run by John Watson Esqr When Surveying the Mill place tract on the 25th day of May 1829 See plat to a post oak corner which is about 25 chains and a short distance after crossing the main road leading from the Said Robert Duncans Dwelling House to the Mill place thence continuing with the Said Watsons Survey See plat about 20 chains to a stone corner on the top of the ridge thence N 29 E 25 to a stake (See general plat made by John Young Esqr on the 8th day of September 1819 thence N. 61.
