towards my Daughter Polly and Son in law Henderson Miller of the district and  
State aforesaid I have given granted and released and by these presents do give  
grant and release unto the said Henderson Miller a certain tract or parcel of  
land whereon said Miller now lives containing one hundred and ten acres  
be the same more or less situate in the district and State aforesaid on branch  
of powhawk creek waters of south Tyger River being part of a tract granted  
to Thomas Bell January 1<sup>st</sup> 1787 Beginning on a stake 3x originally corner  
running thence with original line S.78°W.59 chains to a pine 3x new on said  
line thence S.31°E.48.chains to a stake 3x on the edge of boating ground on original  
line thence with said line N.30°E.54 chains 50 links to the beginning together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to  
have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Henderson  
Miller his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend  
the rights and titles of said premises unto the said Henderson Miller his heirs  
assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and  
Seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and thirty three and fifty seventh year of the American  
Independence

or less being and lying in Greenville district on a branch of Enoree River  
being part of land originally granted to Elisha Simmons begining on  
Joseph Edwards line thence up Maribone Branch to a gum on Magbys line  
thence with Magbys line S2°E to a post oak thence a conditional line to  
a black oak corner on Joseph Edwards line thence a conditional line to the  
beginning corner together with all and singular the rights members  
hereditaments and appurtenances to have and to hold all and
