and sixty three be the same more or less originally granted Grantee to
Daniel Dutton by grant dated 5th of January 1789 and conveyed to Joseph
Evans by Theron Earle John Montgomery and John Miller by Deed dated
the 27th of May 1816 Beginning at a R. oak Running S.W. to achesnut
a conditional corner made by Joseph Evans and Solomon Dill thence
N.W. a conditional line to achesnut a corner of said tract of land
thence N. 20. E. to a conditional Chestnut made by William H West and
