aforesaid have Bargained Granted Sold and released and by these presents do  
Bargain Grant Sell and release unto the said William A Terry a tract of land  
containing one hundred acres more or less Situate in the district aforesaid on  
the Waters of Reedy River Beginning on a stake  $\frac{1}{11}$  near the fork Shoal road thence  
N. 94° E. 27.25' to a stake  $\frac{1}{11}$  on James Woodside's line thence along Said Woodside's line  
S. 66° E. 27.90' to Red oak  $\frac{1}{11}$  thence S. 1. E. 22.70' to Stake  $\frac{1}{11}$  in the field thence  
S. 60° W. 12.50' to Stake  $\frac{1}{11}$  thence N. 58° W. 31.70' to the Beginning corner to have  
and to hold forever from us our heirs assigns etc unto the said William A  
Terry his heirs and assigns administrators etc and against any other person  
or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In testimony  
whereof we do hereby set our hands and affix our seals this first day of October  
A.D. 1833 and in the fifty seventh & fifty eighth year of the Independence of  
these United States
