 of Saludia River & being a part of a tract of land conveyed by Geo Salmon to William
 & Harriett Ford their to Alexander McKenney and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning
 on a white oak the beginning corner of said Salmon's old survey thence North Eighty
 seven degrees West to a white oak original Jackson's corner and now William Mc-
 kenney's originally line thence with said line South Sixty five degrees East to a
 poplar thence South twenty five degrees West to a branch thence up said branch to
 a line of part of the same tract sold by said Ford and since been conveyed to
 Samuel McCanell thence Northwardly crossing an old field to a red oak stump
 formerly a corner thence North thirty one chain fifty links to a red oak thence
 with Standford's old original line to a red oak corner on Henry Ray's line thence
 with said line Northwardly to a white oak sapling corner on the Bull Swamp
 Branch thence down said branch to the head of a ditch that receives said branch
 thence down said ditch to the mouth of a small branch thence up said small
 branch to the beginning white oak corner together with all and singular the rights
 titles, Intercourses, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the
 premises before mentioned unto the said Bensons their heirs and assigns forever and
