Benson's line to a Spanish oak bush Crawfords corner thence N. 61° E. 12. 40 to a
Black oak thence S. 21° E. 53 to a stake 2 chains East of pine stump near
mineys old place original corner thence to the Stump thence S. 65° W. 28. 50
to a black oak bush thence N. 24° E. 10 to the Beginning being apart of the
Real Estate of the Said Robert Benson Deceased to which I as one of his
heirs am Entitled to together with all and singular the members Heredite-
ments rights and appertaining to the Said piece tract parcel or Plantation
