W. 27. ch 20 links to a chestnut thence N. 35 W. 17. ch to a Spanish oak thence N. 87 E. 25 ch to a pine Sapling thence N. 81 E. 11 ch to a pine thence N. 59. E. 31. ch 50 links bordering the Creek to a red oak thence S. 20. E. 13. ch 50 links to a post oak thence E 10 ch to a post oak thence S. 8. E. 8 ch to a post oak thence S. 58.
