formed a board and agreeable to your order laid off the Said Battalion into
four Battalion Companies which are as follows Company No 1 to commence
where the Regimental line goes to Saludia River thence up Saludia to
Beverley Thurstons old place from thence to Nathan Davies thence to Robert
Duncans thence to the main road where it crosses Wests Branch thence up said
Branch to Phillips old trail to the top of Parries Mountain the old original
line thence with said old line to the Tyger Battalion line which divides
the two Battalions thence down said line to where it intersects the regi-
men-tal line thence with said Regimental line to Saludia the Company to
rendezvous at Mc Clanhans old field near Dozens plantation Company
No 2 to commence where Beverley Thurston formerly lived on Saludia
thence up the river to the mouth of the North fork thence up said fork
to W. Thurstons plantation thence to Roy McCoys thence to William Ginsleys
thence to William Bates thence to Martin Sheltons or Richard Thurstons
place on the road thence with said road to the Blue Ball thence to
Sergt Mc Whorter thence to Esquire John Pools to the Battalion line thence
down said line to the upper line of Company No thence with said
line to Saludia River Company to rendezvous at the Widow Bradleys
near the upper end of Paris Mountain Company No 3 to com-
mence at the mouth of the North fork thence up Main Saludia to the middle
fork thence up the South fork to the old line of Company No 3 & Company
No 4 thence to Henry Evanses thence to the mouth of a branch just below Joseph
Mc Junkins thence up said Branch to the head of the same to a small
Hollow between John Bates & Thompson Strouds thence a straight line to the old
house where Arnold Cox formerly lived thence to the mouth of a creek on
the north fork of Saludia thence up said River to the Tyger Battalion line
thence down said Battalion line to John Pools Esquire to the upper line of
Company No 2 thence with said line to the mouth of the North fork
Company to rendezvous at Rowlands old store Company No 4 to com-
mence at the old original line of Company No 3 and 4 on the South
fork thence up said fork of the river to the North Carolina line thence
with said line to where the Battalion line between the Tyger & Saludia
Battalions strikes it thence down said Battalion line to the upper line
of Company No 3 thence with said upper line of Company No 3 to the
South fork of Saludia River Company to rendezvous at Potes old
Muster Ground
