and that she was free before Jack was born and that she is yet  
free and that Jack is free by birth and that her papers are  
Recorded at Pickens Court House sworn to before me Wm Hunter

I do certify that Sarah Sisemore is a free woman of color  
that she has lived in my neighbourhood ever since I have lived  
where I now live which has been about four years and I also  
certify that Jack Ladd has always been called her son which  
is believed to be the case he has lived near me three years but  
does not live at this time at the same place at this time he was  
considered by the Neighbours as an honest boy he also worked  
for himself as if he was free and I have no doubt that he is  
free

State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John  
Pike of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and In considera-  
tion of the sum of Seven hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas O. Lowndes  
of the same State and District have granted Bargained sold and relea-  
sed and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the  
said Thomas O. Lowndes a certain tract piece or parcel of Land situate  
in the district and State aforesaid on Waters of rock Creek. of Enoree  
River and Sowel Creek of ready River containing two hundred and  
sixty acres more or less and hath such bounds Marks &c as follows (viz)  
Beginning at a Chestnut Oak 3x thence S. 48° E. 44.75 chs to a Chestnut 3x thence  
N. 42° E. 20.80 chs to a pine 3x thence S. 33° E. 8.75 chs to a stake 3x on a branch  
thence S. 45° W. 92 chs to a rock 3x thence N. 30° W. 45 chs to a chestnut 3x  
thence N. 60° E. 9.30 chs to a P. oak Bush 3x thence S. 49° E. 17 chs to a pine  
knot 3x thence N. 41° E. 46.20 chs to the Beginning corner a more full descrip-  
tion will appear by reference to a plat hereunto annexed it being part  
of a tract of land originally granted to Levi Howell bearing date
