Greenville District } of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration  
of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander McKenney  
of the same state and district have given granted Bargained Sold released  
and Conveyed and by these presents do give grant Bargain sell release  
and Convey unto him the said Alexander McKenney all that tract or par-  
cel of land Situate lying and being in the district of Greenville and  
state of South Carolina on both sides of the North fork of Saluda river  
and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning on a white oak 3x Running thence  
South 82. W. 10 chain Chest oak 3x thence N. 8. W. 13 chain 15 links to a maple 3x thence  
N. 29° W. 21 chain to a Locust 3x thence N. 65. E. 40 chains to a hickory 3x thence  
N. 70. E. 48 chains to a spanish oak 3x thence S. 10 E 15 chains to a beech 3x  
thence S. 30. W. 30 chain to a pine 3x thence along said McKenney's line to  
the beginning containing four hundred and fifty six acres be the same  
more or less to have and to hold the above granted premises unto him  
the said Alexander McKenney his heirs and assigns forever together with  
all and singular the rights members appurtenances and priviledges  
therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining and I the said  
William Fuller do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns forever to warrant  
and defend the above granted premises unto him the said Alexander  
McKenney his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs executors  
administrators and assigns and against any other person or persons  
whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in  
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth  
day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty four
