State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents that we Isaac Morgan Greenville District Walker Morgan Nathaniel Morgan Samuel Morgan Albert Cunningham & Elizabeth Morgan of Greenville District aforesaid for an incosideration of Seven hundred and one dollars to us paid by I M Morgan of the district and State aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said James M Morgan all that certain piece parcel or tract of Land laying on the north Side of the Enoree River Beginning on the Bank of said River on a dogwood thence N. 51. E. 75 chains to Hickory 38 thence N. 38. W. 18 chains to a post oak 38 thence S. 52. W. 18⁵⁰ to a maple 38 thence S. 6. W. 9 chains 50 links to a pine 38 thence S. 87. W. 16 chains to Hickory 38 thence N. 82. W. 13 chains 50 links to a holly 38 on the Bank of the river thence down the Meanders of said River to the begining containing one hundred and forty five acres it being a part of the tract wherein Sep Morgan deceased owned and lived on his life time adjoining lands of Miller and Mayfield it also being Lot Number one which Applat here annexed will more plainly shew together with all and Singular the rights members hereditements and appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the said I M Morgan his Heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and Singular the said premises unto the said I M Morgan his Heirs and assigns against ourselves our Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof this the thirtieth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four and in the 59 year of the Independence of America in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affix'd our seals
