Know all men by these presents that I James Dunbar of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Eighty Seven dollars to me paid by by William Harrison of the State and district aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and release unto the said William Harrison a certain tract or parcel of land containing thirty seven acres situated in the district and State aforesaid on the Waters of Rabouny Creek being part of a tract of land originally granted to David Peden nine hundred and ten acres granted by his Excellency Charles Pinckney this 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1792 beginning at a stake thence West 4.30 to a red oak 3x thence N. 65. W. 12.50 to a stone 3x N. 16. W. 16.70 to a stone 3x thence S. 65. W. 12.50 to a cypresswood 3x thence N. 35 E 23 to a stake 3x thence S 25 chains to the beginning together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appertainances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever and the said James Dunbar do warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Harrison his heirs and assigns against myself and the heirs of David Peden deceased lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1830.
