 of the Negroes of said Thomas Wadsworth the balance
 of ~~eighty~~ nine acres for the use of the poor school and
 adjoining and adjoining land of John Miller John
 Barnhill and William Keis and the said tract of
 39 acres for the Negroes Together with all and singular
 The rights members belonging or in any way incident
 to a lease for the full term of sixty seven years to the sd
 Baylis Earle his heirs and assigns for that term and I
 do hereby bind myself and my successors in office to sup-
 port and maintain this as a perfect and indefeasible
 lease at law at the signing and sealing of this instru-
 ment and that it shall stand remain and continue
 and be unto the said Baylis Earle his heirs Executors
 and assigns during and for the said term of sixty
 seven years as witness my hand and seal of office this
 11th day of April 1835
