said Absalom Barney Jun<sup>r</sup> all that tract or parcel of  
land situate in the district of Greenville on the north  
side of Enoree River begining at a corner on Tom Edward  
land on a small branch and runs thence S. 85° E. 53.36 a  
creek lick Creek to a post oak corner on A W Crowder  
land thence S. 32 E. 40 to the banks of Enoree River thence up the  
Enoree River to the mouth of the branch on which is the corner at the  
beginning and thence up the said branch to the beginning corner  
being all the land on the north side of said Enoree River as laid down  
in a plat by Thomas P Hudson dated the 24<sup>th</sup> August 1832 together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertainances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said Absalom Barney Jun<sup>r</sup> his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for  
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Absalom  
Barney Jr his heirs and assigns against myself and against every  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof witness my hand and seal this fifteenth day of January  
in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
five and in the fifty ninth year of the independence of the United  
States of America
