

unto the said W. Taylor his heirs and assigns forever and I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
W. Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against  
every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this twenty six day of  
Feby in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
five and in the fifty ninth year of the American Independence

heirs and assigns all her interest and Estate and also all her right and  
claim of dower of in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned  
and released given under my hand and seal this July 30<sup>th</sup> 1835
