

South Carolina; Know all men by these presents that I John H. Harrison for the sum  
Greenville District 3 of six thousand dollars to me paid by John H. Harrison Junr  
do hereby Grant Bargain & Sell and release unto the Said John H. Harrison Junr his  
Heirs and assigns all that had or paicel of Land in Said State and district viz.  
Beginning at sweat Gum 3x on the East Bank of Reedy River below the bridge  
thence by the road till it crosses the old road called Kellets Road at or near the  
corner of Dr. Eddies fence thence by the old path which is the line of border  
old place so as to include the same as conveyed to me by Hudson Morris Esqr  
to the pine corner on Micajah Jenkins line thence on the same to the post oak  
3x on Winn's line thence on the same N.E. 24° to the original corner a white  
oak by alanch thence down the branch to Bright Creek and down the  
same by common High Water Mark as it now runs to Reedy River thence down  
the middle of the River as it now usually runs to the begining containing  
five hundred acres be the same more or less being part of three several tracts  
viz Thomas Jenkins land Richard Lynn and Micajah Jenkins to have  
and to hold the said tract of Land as above described to the Said John  
H. Harrison Junr his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my  
self my heirs Executors &c to warrant and forever defend the said premises  
against myself my heirs and assigns as well as against every other person or  
persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof I witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 14 day of  
March 1835 signed sealed & delivered

Greenville district and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars  
to me in hand well and truly paid by Marshall Shelton of the same place the  
receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained Sold released  
conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant Bargain Sell release  
convey and confirm unto the Said Marshal Shelton his heirs and assigns all  
that plantation tract or paicel of Land containing ten acres be the same more  
or less situate in Greenville district and State aforesaid on the waters of Enoree  
and runs as follows Beginning on a black oak corner on or near a conditional  
line betwixt Hubys old tract and 3 Bensons thence to a spanish oak then  
to a pine thence to Black Locust thence to a mountain oak on the mountain  
path 3 Sheltions line thence along said path to a black Jack corner on  
Sheltions line and Hubys old line thence a conditional line to the beginning  
being apart of David Burns old tract together with all and singular the rights  
members & appendemts and appertinances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises above mentioned unto the Said Marshal Shelton his heirs and  
assigns forever and I do for myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned  
unto the Said Marshal Shelton his heirs or assigns against myself my
