from myself my heirs Executors or Administrators to have and to hold the
above mentioned premises unto the Said William Bluffingame his heirs
and assigns and that I warrant and forever defend the same herein under
my Hand and Seal this 1st August AD 1835 and the Sixtieth year of the
Sovereignty of Americans In dependence Signed Sealed and acknowledged
in the presence of Frederick W. Sollee
