aforesaid I have granted, bargained, sold, sold, released, and by these  
presents, do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said John Britton  
all that lot, piece or parcel of Land situate in the Parish of Greenville at  
Greenville Court House in the State aforesaid, being the same conveyed to  
me by deed from George W. Carter dated the third day of October 1815 in three  
Parts or Lots as will appear by Reference to the said deed the first Lot,  
Beginning at a stake at the corner of Publick Square adjoining Capt. E. Williams  
& Wicks' running thence N 74 1/2 W two Hundred feet across lots Nos. 11 & 12 to  
a stake, thence N 15 1/2 E Fifty two and a half feet to a stake thence S 74 1/2 E two  
Hundred feet to a stake, thence S 15 1/2 W Fifty two and a half feet on the side of  
the publick square to the beginning the other two Lots adjoining the above mentioned  
lot known in the plan as Nos. 10 & 13 No. 10, beginning on a stake, running S 15 1/2 W  
152 1/2 feet to a stake, thence S 74 1/2 W 100 feet to a stake thence N 15 1/2 E 152 1/2 feet  
to a stake, thence S 74 1/2 E 100 feet to the beginning, No. 13, beginning on a stake,  
thence S 74 1/2 E 117 1/2 feet to a stake, thence S 15 1/2 W 140 feet to a stake, thence S 74 1/2  
W 117 1/2 feet to a stake thence N 15 1/2 E 140 feet to the beginning the two last containing  
one Acre more or less, for a more minute description, Reference must be made  
to George W. Carter's deed to me which includes all the Lands hereby conveyed  
together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments and appur-  
tenances to the said premises, belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining to  
have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said John Britton, his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby  
bind myself and my heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant, and forever  
defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said John Britton  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every  
very person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part  
 thereof witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of December in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and in the fifty fifth
