aforesaid have granted Bargained sold released and by these presents do  
grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Timothy Keeler all that  
tract or parcel of land situate in the district and State aforesaid laying  
on both sides of the North River commencing at a branch on the south &  
East side of said River thence up said river to the back water of amile  
Pond to be raised by said Keeler or his assigns thence down said river or  
high water to a solid rock thence N. 45. W. 2 to Hickey thence \$50.00.5 to a rock  
thence \$40 E 2 to a maple on said river this tract in sufficient to give full priva-  
ledge for amile dam Pond &c together with all and singular the rights members  
& appendments and appertaining to the same belonging or in any wise  
incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises  
above mentioned unto the said Keeler his heirs and assigns forever and I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Keeler  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this  
27<sup>th</sup> of May 1835 and in the fifty ninth year of the independence of the  
United States
