singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Taylor his heirs and assigns  
herein against myself my heirs and against every person or persons lawfully claiming  
against the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and seal this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1835 and in the sixtieth  
year of american Independence
