presents by the said Hemming hath for the better securing the payment of
two promissory notes this day given by the said box to the said Hemming
each for four hundred dollars payable one in one and the other in two
years both bearing interest from this date hath granted bargained and
sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said George
Hemming all that parcel or lots of land with their improvements in the
Village of Greenville an estate bounded measuring two hundred & twenty
feet on Main Street being the same lots this day conveyed by the said
Hemming to the said box together with all and singular the rights
members & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
to have and to hold the said lots unto the said Hemming his heirs & assigns
and to his own proper use & benefit & who of now and forever in fee simple &
the said box for himself his heirs and assigns doth warrant & will forever
find the title to the said premises unto the said Hemming his heirs and
