of which was originally granted to James Moore and the other to William Reed and
Conveyed to sundry persons reference being thereto had well more fully appear
by Commencing at a Hickory 3x Thence N 22 deg 30' to a stone 3x Thence E 68 deg 92 to
a short oak 3x Thence N 16 deg 30' to a stone 5x Thence S 79 deg E 6 deg 50' to a stone 3x &
Thence N 9 deg W 30 deg 25' to a stone 3x & Thence S 70 deg W 14 deg 50' to a Stake 3x & Thence S 69 deg
E 10 deg 50' to a black oak 3x Thence S 66 deg W 36 deg 50' to the head of a branch and
from the branch to a black gum 3x on the river thence down the meanders
of the said River to the Hickory at which it commences containing one
hundred and eighty five acres together with all and singular Rights mounting
thereunto and appertaining including one half the bridge over Salu-
da River adjoining said tract of land it being my full share of said
bridge to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said John Cockrum his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever
