and State aforesaid have granted Bargained and released and by these
presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said William Pollard
a certain plantation or tract of one hundred and twenty five acres of land
more or less lying in the district aforesaid on a branch of Reedy River being
part of about three hundred acres of land originally Granted to John
Pyle Senr and signed by his Excellency Governor Moultrie the fourth day of
September one thousand seven hundred and eighty six the said one
hundred and twenty five acres is laid out unto the said William Pollard
as follows Beginning on a pine corner of John Evers land on the original
line thence Running on the said original line North to a post oak thence
N. 30. E. 37 chains to a stake corner thence S. 30. E to a stake corner of said Evers
land and from thence Bounding on the said Evers land to the beginning
including one hundred and twenty five acres of land more or less
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the
said premises before mentioned unto the said William Pollard
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said one hundred and twenty five acres of land
more or less with the premises unto the said William Pollard his heirs and
assigns against myself my heirs and all and every other person or persons
whatsoever in witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal the
Twenty seventh day of July one thousand eight hundred and one
