

South Carolina this Indenture made the twenty 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty five  
Between H. J. Gilreath of the one part and Jesse B. Wallace and John H  
Campbell of the part Whitherso that whereas the Said Wallace & Campbell  
Stand indebted to the Said Hardy & Gilreath in the full sum  
of One Hundred dollars by their notes of hand of four hundred  
dollars each all bearing Interest from the 25<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1836 the  
second on the 25<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1837 the third on the 25<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1838

Now this Indenture witnesseth that the Said Wallace &  
Campbell for and in consideration of the Said debt or sum  
payable as aforesaid to the Said Hardy & Gilreath and  
for the better securing the payment thereof to the Said Hardy  
& Gilreath according to the tenor and effect of the notes  
aforesaid and also in consideration of one dollar to the  
Said Wallace & Campbell by the Said Hardy & Gilreath  
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of the  
premises do grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm  
unto the Said Hardy & Gilreath and to his heirs and assigns  
forever all that Tract or plantation of Land lying in  
Greenville District on the Waters of Tupper and Eurus Rivers  
containing four Hundred Acres be the same more or less  
known to be the place where the Said Hardy & Gilreath now live  
where the District Road intersects the State Road bounded  
on the S. E. South S. W. West & N. W. by Lands of Samuel Steyer  
N. W. by lands owned by J. Westwoodland N. by the Madeworth  
N. E. & E. by the same together with all and singular the  
rights members and appurtenances therunto belonging as in  
appertaining and the ordinary and ordinary remainder and  
remainders right and issues and profits thereof to have and
