three hundred dollars to me in hand, now in Elizabeth Horner
of the district and state aforesaid have granted her money, etc and released and to this presents
do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Elizabeth Horner all that plantation or
tract of land containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less originally granted
to Abner Bishop bearing date the fifth day of June 1786 lying and being in the state and
district aforesaid on the south Branch fork waters of Reedy River beginning at Black-
oak 3x timber N. 60 W 39 th to upstroke 3x timber N 36 E 34-58 to stake 3x timber N 86 E 10-50 to
young maple 3x timber N 89 E 10-50 to mouth of small Branch timber S 45 East 8-50 to -
stake 3x timber N 28 1/2 W 15 to Post-oak 3x on Daniel Ford line there N 35 W 31 1/2 chains to
the Beginning corner bound from Abner Bishop to Charles Crawford and from
said Crawford to John H. Wolf of Lawrence and Saide Wolf to J. S. Smith &
from Jno. S. Smith to James Smith and from James Smith to
Gregory Gundiff and now from Gregy Gundiff to Elizabeth
Horner together with all and singular the rights, common
= but understandments and appurtenances belonging to in any
= wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elizabeth-
Horner her heirs executors and administrators firmly by these presents to
Warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned
against myself my heirs executors and administrators or assigns every
other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the said
or any Part thereof witness my hand and seal this 27 day of December
1835 signed sealed and
