Know all men by these presents that we William Payne senior and John Payne both of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina for and in consideration of three hundred and fifty Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by Richard Gaunt of the same District and State hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Richard Gaunt his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by actual survey one hundred and sixty, four acres lying and being on Saluda river in the District and State afterward being the place where John Payne has lived for many years past that a part of a tract of land originally granted to James Blasingame adjoining land bought by said Gentl of John Blasingame lands of persons Johnson and land of Gaunt a plot whereof is hereunto annexed and is made made part of this deed to have and to hold all and singular the premises unto the said Richard Gaunt his heirs and assigns forever together with all and singular the right, members and appurtenances there unto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and we the said William Payne senior and John Payne for for ourselves and heirs Executors and administrators all land singular the premises together with all its rights members and appurtenances unto the said Richard Gaunt his heirs and assigns forever and against us and our heirs and executors and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend also forever all incumbrances of record or of any other kind or nature whatsoever in witness whereof we the said William Payne and John Payne have hereunto set our hands and seals the 22nd day of July
