of the sum of Three hundred and seventy dollars to me in hand
paid William B. Willingham of Anderson District and state aforesaid
have granted Bargained sold and Released unto these presents
to grants bargain will and release unto the said William B.
Willingham all that tract or parcel of Land containing one
Hundred and Eighty five Acres situate in the state and District
aforesaid on the Branches of Dublin Creek Waters of Cooper River
equally granted to James Trappe William P. Riddle and
John Trotter Beginning on a Stake 3rd. then N 38° E 27 chains to a
White Oak 3rd. then S 9° W 45 chains to a red Oak 3rd. then N 78° E 6.50-
to Red Oak 3rd. then S 53° E 36. chains to a Post Oak 3rd. & w. then S 9° W
25 chains to a Spanish Oak 3rd. then S 13° to a Stake 3rd. then S 17° E 42
to a Stake 3rd. then S 91.50 to Post Oak 3rd. then S 7° E 15' to a Post Oak
3rd. then S 33° W 10' to the Beginning & includes one hundred and eighty
five ac. - to the same number less Post Oak with 11.50 to the same less the

promised set my hands and seal this 13 day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thir-
ty four and in the 57 Year of the Sovereignty and indepen-
dence of the United States of America - Being so sealed
and delivered in presence of Isaa Wright *(Signature)*
