and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
to Bagwell all that plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred  
and fifty acres more or less situate in the state and district aforesaid  
lying on the banks of Horse Creek waters of Peeby River Beginning  
at a white Oak 3x at a branch and running thence N $40^{\circ}E$  37 $\frac{1}{2}$  to  
Poplar and white Oak 3x bounded by lot McCullough Land then  
S $61^{\circ}E$  15 to a Spanish Oak 3x thence S $36^{\circ}E$  42 to a black Oak 3x then  
thence N $60^{\circ}E$  24 to a hickory bush 3x thence N $40^{\circ}W$  36 to a dead pine 3x then  
S $36^{\circ}E$  35 80 to a stalle 3x thence N $61^{\circ}W$  33 to a branch thence up the Branch  
the North fork thence up said fork to the Beginning bounded by  
Shumate lands together with all and singular the right number  
and tracts and appurtenances to the same below giving or in any  
wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
to said premises unto the said Jep Bagwell his heirs and assigns  
for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Jep Bagwell his heirs and assigns against  
myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons who may
