1785 the Land to be conveyed beginning at a Spring a white oak below

Boundary the shoal on the north Back where a crop the River to a red Oak near

the beginning of old stone house then running up to lone Bridge then descending

abutment within 30 feet of said River to a Landerman's Land or stable corner then

running up the river to Lewis Rogers lands thence down said River to the mouth

of the Branches thence to the beginning including five acres more or

less and apparel with the shoals & mills to hand & old house well and regular etc
