178' E to a pine 43' thence N 82° 75' to a stake tree & thence S 11° 40' to a maple 34' E 3'
to Red oak 38' thence N 13° 30' to Poplar 134' W 3' to a 38' thence N 68° W 37' to the
beginning including fifty acres together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and sing
ular the premises before mentioned unto the said A.B. King and do
hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend unto the said A.B. King his heirs and assigns forever
against myself and my heirs and against every other person claiming
or to claim lawfully the same or any part thereof in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd December 1836 -
