Greenville District ³¹⁶ District and State aforesaid for and in consideration
of the law and judgment which I have for my son William
West do hereby give grant confirm and invest in him the said William West
all my right title claim or demand of in or to a certain negro girl named
Evilene and a Negro boy named Tobby with the increase of the female for
his own use and benefit for his also one negro man named Toby with this exceptio[n]
Exception that the said negro man Toby is to receive my own right and
property until after the death of both me and my wife Larissa after which period the
said Negro man Toby is to be his the said William West's property absolutely
and forever And I do hereby invest in the said William West his heirs and
assigns forever all my right title interest claim or demand of in or to
the above mentioned Negroes with the above exception forever In
witness of I have caused to set my hand and seal this 16th day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight-hundred and Thirty-nine and
sixty first year of American Independence Signed sealed and delivered
in presence of Jno Watson James West *(Signature)*
