elidene and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant
Bargain and sell also and confirme unto the said William C.
Berney his heirs and assigns forever all that piece parcel of
Land situate lying and being in District of Greenville and State of
South Carolina bounded as follows Beginning at a small poplar tree
on Brushy Creek at the mouth of a branch there being said
Branch 16-50 chs to a Post Oak 37 at the head of the Branch
31-12 W 9 chs to a tall 38 N 6-9 W 35-80 chs to a Post Oak corner
thence N 53 E 39 chs to a small west Elm 38 near the corner
on Brushy Creek near George Williams and thence down the meanderings
of said Creek to the Beginning containing fifty acres more or
less being a part of a tract originally granted to John Hunt
and also the usual ways waters and water courses mines and mineral
houses orchards and all and every the appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise appertaining and the hereditaments and reversionies whatsoever
and whatsoever rents issues and profits of the said land and
precious and every part thereof and all the estate right title interest
claims property and dim and whatsoever of the said Elizabeth Gordon
of in and to the land and premises hereby granted to have and to hold the aforesaid
land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said William C. Berney his

heirs and assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Gordon for herself and
her heirs the aforesaid lands and premises and every part thereof agreed
