see me in hand paid by Thomas Harkins of said District and State aforesaid  
see have Granted Bargained and sold unto the said Thomas Harkins a Tract  
or parcel of Land containing one hundred and fifty Acres situate in the same  
or Lying on the waters of Beavardas Creek Beginning on said branch  
on a White oak 8x below the saw mill Thence N 50 W 12 Chs to a Mulberry  
3x thence N 45 W 35 Chs to a Spanish oak 3x thence N 87 W 10.15 to a Pine 3x  
thence S 65 W 11 Chs to a Black Gum 3x on a Beach Thence up the branch of  
said Branch 10.15 Chs to a Sour wood 8x at the head of said Branch Thence  
to N 35 Chs to State 3 at the mouth of a Branch on the said Beavardas Creek  
Branch down to Creek by the meanders thereof about 34 Chs to a Tree  
formerly a Black Gum by a Chestnut Thence S 87 E 18 Chs to a Beech  
on the Branch formerly a white Stump thence N 15 E 11 Chs to the  
Beginning a young and singular tree standing by a stone fence  
No. 100 Blank top line together with all and singular the rights numbered  
not traverse and appertaining there unto belonging or in anywise in-  
duced or appertaining to have or to hold all singular the premises before mentioned  
all unto said Thomas Harkins his heirs and assigns for ever and the aforesaid  
said Thomas Springfield do bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
to him to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto Thomas Harkins his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs  
and assigns and against any other person or persons lawfully claim-  
ing or to claim the same or any part thereof without my hand  
and seal this the 19<sup>th</sup> day December A.D. 1836.
