McCrary & Nath'l King their heirs & executors &c all that tract or parcel of land, Situate, lying, & being in the State and District aforesaid, on a branch of Gibbes Creek, being lands originally granted to Batt Burdson, bounded by lands of Samuel W. Hill and Hartwell Lester, beginning at a R. O. 3 X on Reese's old road running along said R. N. 66. E. 25 to a Stake 3x thence S. 79 E. 37. to a pine 3x on the new Greenville Road thence S. 15 W. 01. to a Stake 3x thence S. 13 W. 07. to a R. O. 3 x on the old Greenville road, thence up said road to Reese's old road, thence along said road to the beginning corner containing two hundred acres more or less to H. A. V. C. and to H. O. D. all the aforesaid premises hereditaments, appurtenances, rights, titles & interest unto the only use of the said Thomas P. McCrary and Nath'l King their heirs & executors & assigns &c forever, and from every person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
