 of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of
 Three hundred and Twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Ayres Jones
 of the District of Spar'burgh, and State aforesaid Have granted, bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, and release
 unto the said Ayres Jones, all that tract or parcel of land containing two
 hundred acres, be the same more or less, bounded as follows. Beginning
 at a pine CoX on Kennady's line, thence running N. 50. W. 23. to a black Jack
 Co. X, thence So 41. W 38 to a spanish Oak CoX thence along justness line to a
 Green post Oak CoX on Jesse P. Pools line, thence to a large pine, thence on said line to a
 Spanish Oak CoX on Kennady's line, thence on said line to a white Oak Co. X thence
 to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights, members heredita
 rious and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mention
 ed unto the said Ayres Jones, his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby
 bind myself, my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever
 defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ayres Jones
 his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and against every other person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 In witness my hand this 17th day of February in the year of Our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty four Signed sealed and delivered
 acknowledged in presence of H. J. Gilbreath Simon Styles. Isaac Chandler (read)
