 that Lewis Ryle of Greenville District in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of Five Hundred and Forty five dollars and
 to me paid by Shadrach Gamison of Laurens District
 and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
 release unto the said Shadrach Gamison all that Plantation
 or tract of Land containing one hundred and nine acres more
 or less situated in Greenville District lying on the branches of Horse
 Creek waters of Ruddy River beginning on a white Oak 3x near
 the Head of branch running thence S. 53. E. 9. 50. to a post Oak 3x
 thence N. 47. E. 8. 39. 50. to a dead pine 3x thence N. 42. W. 19. 50 to a hickory 3x
 thence N. 50. E. 12. to a Maple 3x on a branch thence down the main
 course of said branch to its junction with an other branch near
 an old still house thence up the meander of said branch
 to the beginning together with all and singular the rights, the
 interest heretofore and appertaining to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Shadrach Gamison his heirs and
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Shadrach
 Gamison his heirs and assigns against myself and my
 heirs and against every other person who should lawfully
 claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal
 this the twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven and in the
 fifth year of the Independence of the United States
