Brownlee of Lawrence district in the State aforesaid in consideration of Ten Thousand and Eighty six dollars to me in hand paid by John Williamson of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Williamson all that Plantation or Tract of Land containing One Hundred and Seventy six acres more or less situate in Lawrence and Greenville Districts lying on line creek waters of Saluda River beginning on a dead pine 3x Running thence N. 42. 34. 19. 75. to a hickory 3x thence S. 52. 34. 45. 50. to a dogwood 3x and line creek bounding on James Looke's Land thence up said Creek 12. 25. to a Stake 3x thence S. 54. E. 15. 00. to a black oak 3x bounding on John Gambrell's Land thence S. 10. W. 2. 50. to a Stake 3x thence S. 36. E. 35. 00. to a stake 3x bounded on Massey's Neighbours Land thence N. 48. E. 21. to a hickory 3x bounding on Joel Ellisons Land thence N. 43. E. 3. to a Pine 3x thence N. 48. E. 48. 50. to a stake 3x bounded on Thomas Cox's Land thence N. 40. W. 3. to a Stake 3x thence N. 48. W. 5. 75. to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the said John Williamson his heirs and assigns forever and I the said George M.
