- aimed and sold and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell  
to Thomas B. Williams all that tract of land in the district aforesaid  
Containing two hundred and thirty-two acres more or less having  
such shape marks and boundaries as are set forth in a deed of the  
said land from the Rev. Mr. B. Johnson to me and on the annexed  
plat reference to which is hereby made to have and to hold the  
premises with all the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances  
thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant  
- to belonging the said Thomas B. Williams his heirs and assigns  
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators  
- ators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the  
premises to the said Thomas B. Williams his heirs Executors  
- administrators or assigns against the claim of all persons  
whosoever In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this thirteenth day of April 1837 signed sealed and  
delivered in presence of  
S. M. Roberts, B. F. Mauldin

South Carolina & personally came B. F. Mauldin before me and made  
Greenville District & oath in due form of Law and said that he saw M.  
Thompson Jr sign seal and deliver the foregoing  
- deed of conveyance unto T. B. Williams for the use & purposes therein  
- mentioned and that John M. Roberts was with himself  
- subscribing witnesses to the due execution of the same sworn to before me
