bearing even date hereunto before me this day have well more  
fully appear and bearing legal Interest and to be paid me as be  
sund for the first day of January A.D. 1840; and wheras it is but just  
the th and reasonable that I should secure the payment of the aforesaid  
in part Recited Band to the said Edward Croft his heirs & ap-  
ples and wheras I am willing & desirous to do so and have agreed  
& consented to sell Release & Mortgage to him the said Edward Croft  
Toff his heirs & assigns for ever the within named following negro slaves  
belonging to wife Syke, Hannah, Sarah, and Phillis with the future inc-  
rement of the number of them to secure the payment of the  
said Band above named now know all men by these presents that  
my self & the said George Croft for & consideration of the premises above  
set forth & also in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me  
my receipt by the said Edward Croft do hereby thereby bargain sell  
the Release & Mortgage to the said Edward Croft his heirs & assigns  
for ever the following negro slaves to Mrs Syke, Hannah, Sarah  
and Phillis with their future issue to have & to hold the said negro  
slaves & each & every of them & their future increase to the said Edward  
Croft his heirs & assigns for ever & the said George Croft  
do hereby bind myself & my heirs to warrant & defend the same  
with all and singular the above named negroes to the said Edward  
Croft his heirs & assigns forever against all persons whoancome  
to his & their anly proper use benefit behoof & advantage for ever or  
The same to sell & dispose of at private or public sale and apply  
proceeds to the payment of the aforesaid in part Recited Band  
and then to secure the demands of the money arising from the  
said sale to the said George Croft as his heirs shall see fit
