South Carolina, & know all men by these presents, that I James Gidley of  
Greenville District, Greenville District, and in the State aforesaid, for and  
in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas  
Springfield Sen<sup>r</sup>, in the State aforesaid, I have granted, bargained,  
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release  
to the said Thomas Springfield Sen<sup>r</sup>. All that tract of land lying, and  
being in the District aforesaid on the waters of Conocoee c. both sides of  
the main road leading from Greenville Court house to Ashville North-  
Carolina adjoining on two sides by the said Springfield, and by  
lands of Maverick, being near where Thomas Hall had a  
shop on said road and near where James Hill's family now lives  
lying the same land I purchased at Sheriff's sale, then sold as  
with Christopher's property by virtue of an Execution (for  
more particular reference see Sheriff's Bills to me) containing  
estimation thirty nine acres more or less. Together with all  
singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances  
the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertain-  
ing to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before  
intended, unto the said Thomas Springfield Sen<sup>r</sup> his Heirs and assigns  
ever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and  
Administrators, to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular  
the said premises, unto the said Thomas Springfield Sen<sup>r</sup> his Heirs  
and assigns, against me my Bills, and against every person whom  
ever. Lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part therew-  
of. witness my hand and Seal, this thirty first day of July in the  
year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty seven  
and in the Sixty second year of the Independence of the United States of America
