

I doth acknowledge & know all men by these presents that we Thomas Edwards
 Senior and Thomas Edwards Junior of Greenville District and State
 aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars
 to us on hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargained sold, released conveyed and delivered unto the
 presents do grant, bargain sell release, convey and transfer unto the
 said Chaney Stroud his heirs and assigns all that plantation tract
 or parcel of land wherein we now live containing five hundred acres
 to be the same more or less, situate in Greenville District aforesaid
 on both sides of the Panther Fork of Marsh Creek waters of Tugger River
 including the whole of a tract of two hundred and fifty acres granted
 to Peter Thomas by a grant bearing date the twentieth of
 October One thousand seven hundred and Eighty four, the balance
 being part of a tract of land of fifteen hundred and twenty acres
 granted to George by a grant bearing date the second of April
 One thousand Seven hundred and eighty seven the whole of land hereby
 intended to be conveyed runs as follows: That is to say, Beginning on
 a white oak on the south side of the Panther Fork, thence south eighty two degrees
 east thirty six chains, and fifty links to a Stake, thence North eight degrees east
 fifty chains to a red oak thence North eight degrees west fifty one chains
 to a Stake and pointes, thence North Sixty five degrees west fourteen chains
 to a small red oak Roddins line thence south Sixty two degrees West Rod-
 dins line forty seven chains to on the north side of the Panther
 fork, thence down the meander of said fork to the mouth of a small branch
 that heads near the fork of the Ashville and Kershaw roads, thence up
 the said branch to its source, thence up the hollow of the same a straight line
 to a red Oak near the fork of the said roads, thence North forty degrees east
 to a post Oak, thence North ten degrees East west three chains and fifty
 links to the beginning, containing in the whole five hundred acres more
 or less aforesaid together with all and singular the rights Members
 Freedamants and appurtenances to the same premises belonging or
 in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and
 singular the premises above mentioned to the said Chaney Stroud, his
 heirs and assigns for ever, and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs
 Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend the above
 described premises unto the above named Chaney Stroud his Heirs
 Executors and Administrators and assigns against our selves, our
 Heirs Executors and Administrators and against all and every person
 or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
 any part thereof In witness whereof we have set our hands and affixed
