

Know all men by these presents that whereas we John McCowanhan of this and County of Morgan wife of the said John McCowanhan of Morgan County and State of Missouri are seized in fee by deed from Elias Earle deceased of and in all that forth tract or parcel of land of Four hundred acres be the same more or less lying and being on Langston Creek a branch of Reedy River in Greenville District had South Carolina Now know ye that we the said John McCowanhan and James Nancy his wife Have made constituted and appointed and by these presents money to make constitute and appoint Samuel G. McCowanhan of said Greenville District and Said State of South Carolina our true and lawful Attorney for us and in our names to lease, let, sell or demise the aforesaid tract of land to any such person or persons, and for such time, or number of years and at and under such yearly and other rents as he shall think fit, or otherwise to sell, grant and convey the same absolutely in fee simple for such price or sum of money to such person or persons as he shall think fit and convenient, and also for us and in our names to seal, execute and deliver deeds, conveyances, bargains and sales for the absolute sale and disposal thereof, with such clauses, conveyances and agreements to be therein contained as our said Attorney shall think fit and convenient. We do hereby ratify and confirm all such leases, deeds, conveyances, bargains or sales into which shall at any time hereafter be sealed and executed by our said Attorney touching or concerning the premises. We witness whereof the said John McCowanhan and Nancy his wife hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals on the 14th day of December 1836. John McCowanhan and Nancy McCowanhan Seals

Be it remembered that at a court held for said County at the Courthouse in Versailles on Wednesday the fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty six in the said County John McCowanhan and Nancy McCowanhan and present in court the attorney and they being personally known to the Clerk of Court as always the persons whose names are subscribed to said letter of attorney being ignorant thereof and severally acknowledged the same to be their act done for the purpose therein mentioned. In testimony whereof and because the same is to be done in our said Court I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal of office at Versailles on the 14 day of December 1836.
